It has been brought to our attention, a business with only a post office box address in New Jersey is using the name of **Troyan** and may be drafting Qualified Domestic Relations Orders (“QDRO”). We are aware this confusion may leave some Attorneys in the Family Law community to believe they are hiring this firm's services, which is incorrect. Neither **Rodney D. Troyan**, Esquire nor **William M. Troyan** are affiliated or associated with any other organization using the name Troyan.

That firm, is not a Law Firm and may be engaging in the unauthorized practice of law. As you are likely aware, the States consider drafting of QDROs by non-lawyers to be the Unauthorized Practice of Law. If any fees for services have been paid to that firm, and they are unwilling to issue a refund or to produce its Attorney's ID number, you may be able to seek redress by contacting the Office of Attorney Ethics in your jurisdiction.

We have recently modified the name of our firm to Troyan & Associates, P.A. (The [QDROAttorney.com](http://QDROAttorney.com) Firm) (formerly known as Troyan, Inc.) to distinguish ourselves from the firm imitating us. Our office is only located in Sarasota, FL, however, both myself and William Troyan were formerly located in New Jersey. Our firm and its staff have prepared more than 155,000 QDROs. Both, William M. Troyan and Rodney D. Troyan, Esquire, are not affiliated or associated with any other firms.

Again, the firm of Troyan & Associates, P.A., has all of its QDROs prepared by a licensed Attorney. Our firm for no additional fee has its QDROs "pre-approved" by the Plan Administrator when available. The case law in your jurisdiction also indicates that hiring a non-lawyer to prepare a QDRO, is a non-delegable legal duty.
